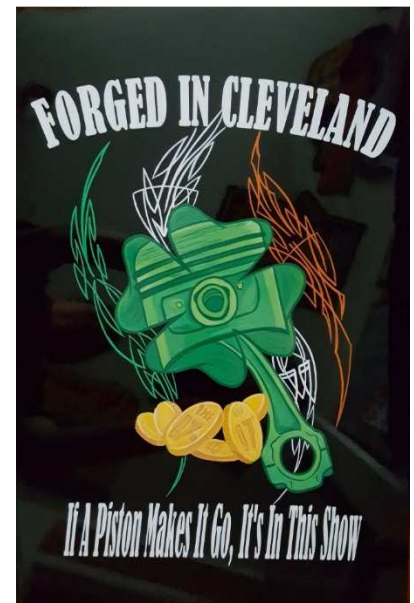

The Krazy Paint Pinstripers created these designs for the 2017 Summit Racing Equipment I-X Piston Powered Auto-Rama Presented by Rad Air Complete Car Care and Tire Center. The judging is done by a panel of five judges, applying the following criteria:

- Originality/uniqueness of design/appearance (50%)
- Appropriateness to theme (25%)
- Creativity (25%)

“This year’s winning design becomes the design for the back of the event main hall t-shirt that will be sold at the show. Attendees will be able to purchase one of these at our merchandise stand, inside the West entrance as they enter the show,” said Show Manager Steve Legerski.

The 1st place prize is \$500, 2nd place prize is \$250, 3rd place prize is \$100. The winners receive their checks at the show in March. Charity art auctions will take place each day on the main stage of the I-X Piston Powered Auto-Rama. Items scheduled to be auctioned include Kustom Art, art panels and many other unique items.
